This match is a selection match for the State team as per selection criteria

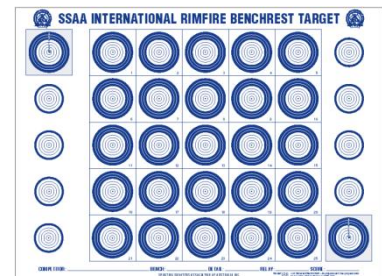

RIFLE SPECIFICATIONS

The Championship will be completed under one class of rifle, this to be any rifle chambered in 22LR with a maximum weight of 14lbs (6.35KG) without restriction on trigger weight (pull) or scope power. The trigger must be manually operated and it is the competitor's responsibility to ensure its safe operation. The stock shall not exceed 3 inches in width at the fore-end, be of conventional design and to be stable and safe to operate – rifle must be controlled safely. The rifle must meet the Legislative Authority requirements applicable at the Host Branch / Club for the class of rifle.
